HISTORY WORK SHOP 1: NATIVE AMERICANS

INTRODUCE THE LGBT+ TOPIC.

Questions:

- Have you heard about the term LGBT+?
- What do you know about it?
- Do you think LGBT+ people were always around us?
- Do you know someone that is LGBT+?

The teacher can give some personal input like: if they know someone who is LGBT+ or can mention a famous LGBT+ person to create a positive and open space for discussion. (Let the discussion flow for few minutes)

START AND GO THROUGH THE SLIDE SHOW.

REFLECTIONS.

- Ask students what they think and feel about what they heard and saw in the slide show.
- Did they change their ideas or perspectives about LGBT+ people?
- If there were LGBT+ students in the classroom, how would they feel seeing this presentation?
