HISTORY WORKSHOP 3: STONEWALL

START THE WORK SHOP

SLIDE 1

Wait for the students' response

SLIDE 10

- Ask students if they ever experienced discriminatory remarks towards LGBT+ people at school or outside school.
- If they themselves ever insulted someone because the person might have looked gay, too effeminate or too masculine etc. Why did they do it and would they do it now? Why?
- If they were insulted because they might look gay, too effeminate or too masculine etc. or if were insulted with derogatory terms such as "pufta" for reasons that have nothing to do with being LGBT+. How did that make them feel at that time and have they changed perspective now?

(Create a safe and open space so that students feel free to discuss. A personal experience from the teacher can help a lot)

- How do they feel about the three workshops.
- Did the workshops make them change perspective on LGBT persons? How?
